MINUTES

**Town of Slaughter
Regular Meeting
August 14, 2018**

- I. **CALL TO ORDER**--The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Jackson, who opened the meeting at 6:50 p.m., August 14, 2018 at the Slaughter Town Hall, 3337 Church Street, Slaughter, Louisiana. A quorum was present and due notice was given. Unless otherwise noted all motions passed by unanimous decision of the Board.

 - A. **Brian Capone- 2940 Landmor Drive- approval for 600 sq ft workshop- Contingent upon meeting 10 foot setbacks on the side. Motion by: Landry. Second by Aaron. Motion Passed.**
 - B. **Jeff Moore- 1113 Midway Road- Application for re-subdivision of property with provision that the lot sizes can be changed to meet the requirements of town regulations. Plans to be reduced from 9 lots to 8. Contingent upon lot size being 100 feet for R-1 zoning. And contingent upon set back of 20 feet in back from airport with 10 feet on each side and 30 foot set back on the front.—Mr. Moore was in attendance and made a presentation to the Board with regard to property values and drainage concerns. He also stated that he was going to only develop 7 lots rather than 9. Those with concerns were given ample opportunity to ask questions and express their concerns over the development. Liz Aaron requested that the parish engineer to review the drainage. Mr. Moore requested to be treated in the same manner as others that build in the area and expressed concern that he was being singled out. Mayor Jackson pointed out that so few families live on Magnolia and so many live in Ashcliff it would more benefit to the larger population to put the money into Ashcliff. Substitute motion by Janice Landry to approve the funding for Ashcliff. Second by Fletcher. Motion Passed. 3-2 with Aaron and Corcoran voting opposed. Motion to CWF- motion by Landry. Second by Aaron. Motion Passed.**
